Interns will get to experience the examination process of incoming wildlife, learn different treatment techniques, capture and release wildlife in our care, learn different husbandry requirements for the many different species WCSV receives, and assist staff in training new volunteers. Interns will also have an opportunity to learn different diagnostic techniques such as avian and mammal fecal testing and blood work.

## REQUIREMENTS:

- You need to have reliable transportation to and from the Wildlife Center
